8TH GRADE REWARD TRIP CRITERIA

Effective January 2012

This criteria has been set to establish a standard for students to be eligible to attend the 8th grade reward trip.

Every student must have a C- or better average for the last two grading periods in all subjects (English, Math, Reading, Science, and History, and exploratory classes.)

The following disciplinary actions will automatically remove students from attending the trip: Any school suspensions. At the discretion of building administrators and staff, students may be removed from the reward trip for receiving 3 or more detentions and/or two Friday Schools or a combination of disciplinary actions.

Attendance is also an important factor for the trip. Any student with 10 or more absences in the second semester will be prohibited from attending the reward trip.
