

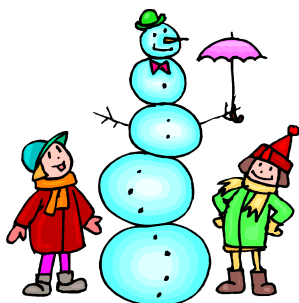

Talent Show Guidelines

1. All acts must be completely organized and ready to perform by the first practice. Only students from Lincoln or Shute will be allowed to perform.
2. You must be able to attend the practices, wear your performing costume at the dress rehearsal and be accompanied by a parent or guardian to the dress rehearsal.
3. Clothing must conform to the school dress code as listed in the Student Handbooks. (e.g. no bare midriffs or shoulders)
4. All music must be approved by the talent show coordinators prior to the first rehearsal.
5. Provocative dance/gestures will not be allowed.
6. Acts must be the same as performed at the dress rehearsal.
7. Students will be allowed to perform only 1 act.
8. All acts must be kept around 1 1/2 minutes in length.
9. Late entries will not be accepted.
10. Anyone not willing to follow these rules will not be allowed to participate in the talent show.

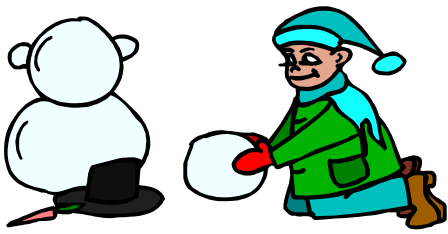

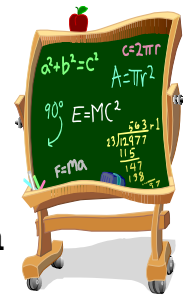

Arrival / Dismissal Times
