## Spotlight on the Music Room

## Student Meal Accounts

School meals in District 86 are available to all of our students. The cost of providing meals continues to rise for the District as for your own family.

Meals are a "prepaid" item for our students.

We ask that you maintain a positive balance for your student's account.

When a student's meal account balance falls below zero, you will receive a reminder from the District to add to their account.

Occasionally, it is necessary to substitute an alternative lunch for a student with an excessive negative balance on their account. It will consist

of the minimum requirement for school meals which is a small sandwich and a milk.

Additionally, these students will not be allowed to take extra side dishes, purchase water, or have dessert.

No child, however, will go without being given a lunch of some kind in this school District.

For students to enjoy all the regular lunch, families will need to keep a positive balance on their meal account.

Stop by the library Friday afternoon **October 28** between **4:00** and **5:00** to make a fun and spooky Halloween craft. Supplies are provided.

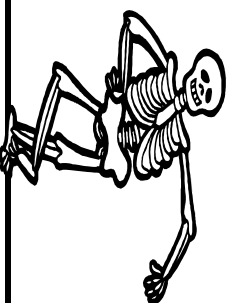

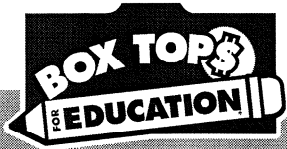
